## RDAP FACTS

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>An inmate must have at least a 37 month sentence to be qualified to participate in RDAP.</li> <li>An inmate may request an RDAP interview when they are between 24-38 months from release. If you don't have time to transfer to RDAP before 24 months, you cannot be re-designated for RDAP and can become unqualified.</li> <li>Designations to an RDAP facility are based on the following guidelines: <u>Primary consideration</u>: remaining length of sentence. Does the RDAP have a class starting soon enough to allow the inmate to complete the nine month program and six months of Residential Re-entry Center housing prior to release. RDAP participants are expected to complete six months of RRC. This means that participants may receive LESS than 12 months off of their sentence. <u>Second consideration</u>: distance from release designation. Is there an RDAP within 500 miles of the city where the inmate will be released? <u>Other important considerations</u>: Security level, care level, RDAP group starting dates.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If the inmate is notified of a transfer for RDAP placement and he refuses the transfer, he will be considered to have declined RDAP and removed from the waiting list.</li> <li>If an inmate who declined RDAP would later like to participate, he will be transferred to the originally recommended RDAP facility</li> <li>Inmates with an INS detainer are not qualified to participate in RDAP because RRC cannot be completed.</li> <li>Inmates will not necessarily get a year off of their sentence for completion of RDAP, depending on the instant offense and other prior adult convictions like manslaughter, rape, sex abuse, assault, detainer, etc. These offenses will exclude an inmate from going to an RRC which is important for continuity of treatment.</li> </ul>
